MASTER 1 DEVELOPMENT ECONOMICS INITIAL TRAINING

OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this Master program Development Economics is to train economists with very good knowledge about the theories and empirical methods of economics and expertise on the specific issues of economic development. The objective is to meet the growing demand for experts able to meet the challenges of economic development process, to evaluate the economic policies of developing countries and to integrate these policies in the issues of globalization and sustainable development.

The program combines the benefits of a thorough training in economics and an introduction to a concrete field of application, which also opens on understanding other disciplinary approaches on development.

Courses are both in French or in English.

It is also possible to follow a two-years program with all courses in English starting in Master 1. In that case, you will have to apply to the Paris Sorbonne Master in Economics (PSME). The PSME is a program custom-made for international students wishing to study Economics at the Sorbonne. The PSME program is a first year of Graduate Studies (Diplome Universitaire) which offers Economics courses taught in English, together with intensive courses of the French language. It offers the possibility to get the Master 1 Development Economics by equivalence, allowing students to pursue their studies in Master 2 Development Economics or Economics of Sustainable Development.

ACADEMIC BACKGROUND

Bachelor in economics, with good theoretical and empirical knowledge on the fundamentals of economics and an openmindedness on other social sciences.

THE SELECTION PROCESS

European candidates ou students with a French diploma should apply through E-CANDIDAT from **04/04/2019 to 19/04/2019**. Candidates from countries with Campus France procedure have to apply through Campus France from March 1st to March 18th. Other foreign candidates should apply through E-CANDIDAT from **04/04/2019 to 19/04/2019**. Applicants should include a motivation letter.

The program offers basic mandatory classes :

It also includes a dissertation, contributing to the professionalization of students.

This program rests on the research group on the economics of sustainable development of the Centre d'Économie de la Sorbonne. The program benefits from closed cooperation with international development actors, such as the French Development Agency, UNESCO, OECD, the World Bank, the African Development Bank or ILO, as well as with civil society actors.

International partnerships

The program is largely internationalized with cooperation with prestigious universities in developing countries. We offer a double-degree at the Cairo University. A student mobility program is also proposed at Cairo during the second semester of the Master 1. Other mobilities are possible, in particular at the Javeriana University of Bogota or the University of Cape Town.

MAIN CAREER OPPORTUNITIES (AFTER M1)

It is best to pursue studies in $\mathsf{M2}$ for proper integration into the labor market.

FOLLOWING PROGRAMMES (MASTER 2)

After the M1, the program proposes two Master 2.

• The M2 «Development Economics» trains future experts and researchers specialized in development. After the M2, students can start a Ph-D or work in the expertise of development.

• The M2 «Economics of Sustainable Development» trains professionals in charge of the conception, implementation and evaluation of sustainable development policies.
